# 30<sup>th</sup> Stockport Beer & Cider Festival

The 2016 Festival was a great success with 5,000 people through the door, cask beer sales per head up, only 50 bottles unsold on the bottled beer bar, record Saturday cider sales and for the first time an incredible 100 new CAMRA members recruited. I have received wonderful comments about the Festival overall, as well as specifically about the quality of the beer, cider and entertainment, all saying that it was a really great event. Everybody who contributed should be very satisfied as it was due to your efforts that people enjoyed themselves so much. I would particularly like to thank the organising committee who worked so hard to put the festival on.

Subject to contract the Festival is returning to Edgeley Park for 2016 but we need a new organising committee to rise to the challenge. In particular Chris Wainwright, our illustrious **Chief Beer and Bar Manager**, will be stepping down after next year's festival. We need to replace him if we are to continue with future beer festivals, and we would like his replacement(s) to act as his apprentice(s) in 2017. If you volunteer for this vital, interesting and stimulating role (ideally we need more than one person) not only will you be trained but also Chris will be there to guide and mentor you even after he steps down.

On a wider note, quite a number of our management team are in their sixties and seventies and we must have new people coming through to learn from, and eventually replace, them. I promise you will receive training, guidance and mentoring, so please volunteer.
